Brooklyn Center Animal Control Review Panel

The City of Brooklyn Center is seeking an individual to fill a member vacancy on the Animal Control Review Panel. The member position is voluntary. To qualify for membership, you must have an interest in dogs or some knowledge of dog behavior, dog training, or dog handling, as well as an interest in protecting the public health, safety, and general welfare of the community.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Animal Control Review Panel will review documents as needed and hear evidence from the appellant to make a determination on a dangerous dog or potentially dangerous dog declaration. The Animal Control Review Panel consists of three members. The City Attorney attends hearings and serves as the moderator.

MEETING TIMES & LOCATION

The Animal Control Review Panel convenes at City Hall when an appeal has been filed by an owner of a dangerous dog or potentially dangerous dog. Hearings are generally held in the evenings.
